Ps 35:28

8 My tongue will speak of your righteousness and of your **praises** all day long. NIV

2 Chron 29:30

Ps 9:11-12

1 Sing the **praises** of the Lord, enthroned in Zion; proclaim among the nations what he has done. 12 For he who avenges blood remembers; He does not ignore the cry of the afflicted. NIV

Ps 9:14

That I may declare your **praises** in the gates of the Daughter of Zion and there rejoice in your salvation. NIV

Ps 18:49-50

49 Therefore I will **praise** you among the nations, O Lord; I will sing praises to your name. 50 He gives his king great victories; he shows unfailing kindness to his anointed, to David and his descendants forever. NIV

Ps 47:6-7

6 Sing praises to God, sing **praises** sing praises to our King, sing praises. 7 For God is the King of all the earth sing to him a psalm of **praise**. NIV

Praise the Lord. How good it is to sing **praises** to our God, how pleasant and fitting to **praise** him! NIV

... Make your **praises** heard, and say, 'O Lord, save your people, the remnant of Israel' NIV

1 Peter 2:9-10

9 But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, and a people belonging to God, that **you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light**. 10 Once you were not a people, but now you are the people of God; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy.
